Sonomono uses natural colored wool, which may cause different colors in batches with the same color number, depending on the production date. We recommend purchasing enough yarn in one batch to complete the garment.

Washable yarns for hand knitting are made with functional materials that can be machine-washed normally. They have a texture highly resistant to change from normal machine washing and are free from shrinking or loosing their shape. They are also resistant to pilling and highly antistatic, which prevents an uncomfortable harsh feeling.

"WANPAKU DENIS" for kids and "LOVELY BABY" for babies are cherished products launched in 1987 and 1989, respectively.

Cautions on using Washable yarns for hand knitting

- Always use standard gauges indicated.
- Use a lingerie laundry bag washing.
- Do not use a dryer.

Why is dirt removed?

• Micro-lines in fiber wipe off dirt!

The Hamanaka Bonny series uses acrylic monofilaments, which have microscopic micro-lines (streaks) and grooves along the surface when seen with a microscope. These ridges and grooves in micrometers (1/1000 millimeters) scrape off dirt, resulting an excellent washing without detergent.

Soft elastic characteristics help remove dirt!

The Hamanaka Bonny series consists of comparably thick acrylic fibers, which adds elasticity to the varns Due to its softness and elasticity, together with its tension and resilience, the product perfectly fit on the surface of washed tableware, thereby exerting an excellent wiping-off performance.

Breathability and water permeability help remove dirt!

The Hamanaka Bonny series consists of multiple types of acrylic monofilaments having different thicknesses and natures, including conjugatedfiber, bulky fiber, and regular fiber, bringing bulkiness to the yarns. This creates a lot of space between the fibers for excellent water penetration and quick removal of dirt from the fabric. It also has an excellent breathability, so it dries quickly.


Moreover...top-dyeing

The Hamanaka Bonny Series yarns are top-dyed. After dyeing raw materials (staple fiber), they are spun and bulk-processed to achieve soft, bulky and voluminous yarns. They don't shrink in the wash, they dry quickly, and they retain their fluffiness they are also processed to have anti-bacterial and deodorant effects, making them very clean! In addition to Bonny Scrubbers, the Bonny series is been widely used for many other knitted and crocheted items such as cushions, and stuffed toys.

First determine the size in millimeters (mm) for the hook specified, then choose the closest hook size that is most comfortable to use.
